

Privacy Notice for Student Scholarships

This Privacy Notice explains who we are, how and why we collect and use personal information about you, our lawful basis, relevant retention periods, and how you can exercise your privacy rights. Please do read this notice to understand our practices at Page Industries Limited and if you have any questions please contact us using the contact details provided below.

Who we are

Page Industries Limited (**'Page'**) is the Data Controller/ Data fiduciary in respect of the personal data you provide. Page manages personal data in accordance with the Digital Personal Data Protection Act 2023 (DPDPA) of India.

The personal data we process

The personal data we collect about you may include the following:

- i. Personal details of the applicant student such as title, name, address, telephone number, email address, date of birth and gender;
- ii. Educational history information which includes Academic Merit/qualification information, marksheet, certificate;
- iii. Government Identification documents such as Aadhar Card, Bank Passbook ,;
- iv. Academic Merit/qualification information;
- v. Funding and financial support information such as household/parental income.

We may also process the following special category personal data:

Information about criminal convictions and offences (if the same has any impact on your course).

Most of this information comes from your application, either via your Schools, Universities and Colleges Admission Service or your direct application. We may also collect additional information from third parties, including the disclosure services, referees, previous schools, colleges and universities. We may also share your information with third parties, if those third parties form or are part of a panel that will make a decision on your application.

The purpose and lawful basis of the processing

We process personal data with a view to entering into a sponsorship relationship with you.
We process personal data in order to fulfil our obligations to you.

Assess and manage your scholarship application.

Confirm that you have enrolled on higher secondary/ diploma/ new full undergraduate degree programme in the relevant academic year.

Confirm that you have a valid government identification number.

Verify that you applied online to be assessed by PAGE and affiliated service providers in respect of your income.

Verify that you will be paying tuition fees and you will be self-funding. Your course of study must not be externally funded.

Confirm that you have demonstrated financial need, and your household income indicates that you are eligible for means-tested support from PAGE with a family household income less than Rs. 3,60,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Sixty Thousand only) per annum.

Share your data with third party panel members. We may also share your information with third parties, if those third parties form or are part of a panel in order to be able to make a decision on your application.

Deal with your enquiries and to make contact with you when you request information from us.

Handle any complaints you may have so that we can improve our services.

Consent: we offer you as real choice and control whether you wish to participate in these activities unless the requirements form part of the terms and conditions of the scholarship in which case we process your information.

Contact you about events or activities which are held for our scholarship recipients and that we think may be of interest to you.

Invite you to participate in student focus groups and/or surveys.

Invite you to be involved in our marketing activities, which may include using your image or creating videos, vlogs or social media content.

Determine whether any adjustments need to be made for you if you have declared a disability.

Take account of, and provide additional support for, any disabilities, health issues or conditions.

Disclosures to third parties

To help us convey the impact of supporting scholars, successful scholars are asked to provide regular updates on their progress on the programme and a short report at the end of each academic year.

The right to withdraw consent

If we have collected and process your personal information with your explicit consent, then you can withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawing your consent will not affect the lawfulness of any processing we conducted prior to your withdrawal, nor will it affect processing of your personal information conducted in reliance on lawful processing grounds other than consent. Data retention

Your personal data will only be retained for as long as it is necessary in accordance with the applicable law *or until completion of CSR Impact Assessment whichever is earlier*. We will retain the personal data relating to financial support and student tuition fees of successful applicants until the termination of our scholarship relationship with you or as per the requirements of applicable laws. This includes:

- i. Records documenting remission of tuition fees in exceptional circumstances.
- ii. Records documenting the collection and receipt of tuition fees.
- iii. Invoices documenting the payment of financial aid funds and bursaries to individual students.
- iv. Records documenting payment of prizes.

Your rights in respect of the processing

- i. The right to be informed – this privacy notice assists with fulfilling these obligations.
- ii. The right of access to personal information held about you in order to be aware of, and verify, the legal basis of the processing.

- iv. Right to nominate any individual in the event of death or incapacity to exercise the rights as per applicable law.
- v. The right to rectification.
- vi. The right to correction and erasure of personal data.
- vii. The right to grievance redressal.
